Getting Started with ArtistWorks

ArtistWorks provides world-class instruction for the most popular string and band instruments through self-paced video lessons from professional musicians. Learn instruments like guitar, harmonica, banjo, ukulele and more! Courses include video instruction, play-along tracks, downloadable written materials, tablature, and sheet music, and more.

Its strength is in musical genres like blues, bluegrass, jazz and rock. Courses are taught by expert instructors, and can be accessed 24/7 for free using your library card.

IMPORTANT: ArtistWorks must be accessed through Libby from OverDrive.

- On a mobile phone or tablet, you must download the Libby app.
- On a computer, or any device that doesn’t have the Libby app, users can access it from the browser-version of Libby: <https://libbyapp.com/library/sclibrary>

Do not try to create an account in the ArtistWorks app, as this won’t be linked to the SCL subscription.

Accessing ArtistWorks

Use Libby

- Mobile device: Install the Libby app, found in your app store or on <https://www.overdrive.com/apps/libby>
- Computer: In your Chrome, Firefox, Safari, or Edge browser visit <https://www.overdrive.com/apps/libby>

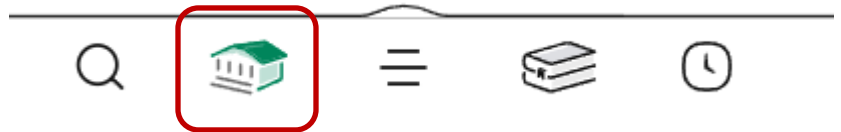
Reminder: You must go through Libby, you can’t go through ArtistWorks’s website/app.

Sign in with Valid Library Card

- In Libby click “Sign In” if you haven’t already done so and follow the prompts.
- You will be asked for your **14-digit library card number** and **PIN**. (This library PIN is the same PIN you use when you use any other online library resource or service)

Browse the Library’s Resources in Libby

Make sure you are using the menu icon for the library.



Scroll to Extras

From the library home screen, scroll down to the Extras header (past Magazines, and the box guides for Kids, Teens, Magazines, etc.). Click on ArtistWorks, and then the “Get” button.

Follow the remaining prompts to get to the ArtistWorks content.
