Getting Started with Craftsy

Craftsy is an online resource for all creative makers from basic instruction to advanced techniques for fabric and yarn crafts, baking, drawing, and much more. Craftsy contains self-paced video tutorials with over 1,300 courses in drawing, knitting, photography, quilting & more! Each course includes downloadable class materials like patterns or recipes to support the video.

Courses are taught by expert instructors, and can be accessed 24/7 for free using your library card. You check out a 7 day pass, which grants access for the week, after which you can "checkout" another 7 day pass for continuing access.

IMPORTANT: Craftsy must be accessed through Libby from OverDrive.

- On a mobile phone or tablet, you must download the Libby app.
- On a computer, or any device that doesn't have the Libby app, users can access it from the browser-version of Libby: https://libbyapp.com/library/sclibrary

Do not try to create an account in the Craftsy app, as this won't be linked to the SCL subscription.

Accessing Craftsy

Use Libby

- Mobile device: Install the Libby app, found in your app store or on https://www.overdrive.com/apps/libby
- Computer: In your Chrome, Firefox, Safari, or Edge browser visit https://www.overdrive.com/apps/libby

Reminder: You must go through Libby, you can't go through Craftsy's website/app.



Sign in with Valid Library Card

- a. In Libby click "Sign In" if you haven't already done so and follow the prompts.
- b. You will be asked for your **14-digit library card number** and **PIN**. (This library PIN is the same PIN you use when you use any other online library resource or service)
